

WAVE 3 ARTIST ENTRY/CONTRACT 2022

By signing below:

1. I understand that if my Herons on the Bayou design is selected to be a winning design and I accept the opportunity, I will receive \$250 initially and a customized kit of approved paint, then \$500 upon completion and delivery of the Heron, as long as the final project adheres to the original submitted design.

2. I understand that the Herons will be placed in public areas, so appropriateness for a public viewing audience must be considered.

3. I understand that the judging will be completed by a "blind" panel who will not see artists' names.

4. I understand if my Heron design is selected, I will be responsible for completing the design as submitted. If the finished design does not adhere to the original submitted design, the Downtown Arts Alliance will not be held responsible for final payment. If I am unable to complete the design I will be responsible for reimbursing the initial \$250 to The Downtown Arts Alliance.

5. I understand that colorfastness is an integral component to this outdoor, public art project, so I will only use the high quality materials provided for me by the Downtown Arts Alliance.

6. If selected, I am responsible for the pick up and delivery of the heron.

7. I understand that I am not to put a sealant on the Heron or to install it at any location.

8. I understand the following timeline:

Design Deadline: November 11, 2022 by 5:00PM.

Email to heronsonthebayou@gmail.com or turn in phsically on the due date at a location TBD.

Selected artists will be notified of winning submissions the first week of December, 2022.

9. I understand that there will be a two month completion time frame for the Herons on the Bayou project. This will be in March of 2022. Specific dates are TBD. The Downtown Arts Alliance will notify artists in advance when the blank Herons will be ready for pick up.

10. Should an Art Educator's Class decide to submit designs the Educator will be responsible for making sure the design meets the requirements. All grade levels are encouraged to participate.

11. I certify that my contact information listed below is current and factual.

Material Considerations:

All paints will be provided by the Herons on the Bayou committee. We will supply you with Nova Color Artists Acrylic Paint, quantities and colors based on your submitted design. You will not be allowed to use any other brands. No designs featuring collage or mixed media will be accepted. Mosaic designs will be accepted but artists must provide samples of previous works.
